# OhioHealth MyChart

OhioHealth MyChart is your personalized and secure online health record that helps you take charge of your health.

- + Schedule non-urgent future appointments
- + View your past and upcoming appointments
- + Request a medication renewal and select a pharmacy
- + Get medical advice and answers to non-urgent questions
- + Review a record of your OhioHealth hospital, emergency, outpatient, urgent care or physician office visit

## Activate your OhioHealth MyChart Account

- + **Step 1:** Get an activation code
  - Call your OhioHealth primary care physician's office, or ask the medical receptionist for your activation code. You may also go to [mychart.ohiohealth.com](https://mychart.ohiohealth.com) to request your activation code.
  - Your activation code will enable you to log in the first time and allow you to create your own username and password.
  - Your activation code is good for 30 days.
- + **Step 2:** Activate your account
  - Go to [mychart.ohiohealth.com](https://mychart.ohiohealth.com) and follow the instructions to log on with your email address, activation code and the last four digits of your social security number.
  - You will create a password. Save this in a secure place.
