

- Review a record of your OhioHealth hospital, emergency, outpatient, urgent care or physician office visit

Activate your OhioHealth MyChart Account

- + **Step 1:** Get an activation code
 - Call your OhioHealth primary care physician's office, or ask the medical receptionist for your activation code. You may also go to mychart.ohiohealth.com to request your activation code.
 - Your activation code will enable you to log in the first time and allow you to create your own username and password.
 - Your activation code is good for 30 days.

+ **Step 2:** Activate your account

- Go to mychart.ohiohealth.com and follow the instructions to log on with your email address, activation code and the last four digits of your social security number.
- You will create a password. Save this in a secure place.
